WATCHING THE MOVIE version of a book is NOT SATISFACTORY for testing purposes. Books are often different from the movies and can confuse the student when the evaluation is given.

Books over which the student has already taken an AR test **do not count** as “new/summer” reading!!

A student will need a copy of their books the first three days of school at minimum.
